Electronic Timesheets Now Available!



The California Department of Social Services is pleased to announce the availability of the Electronic Time-sheets Website. Effective June 5, 2017, In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Recipients and Providers have an option to enroll, submit and approve timesheets online via Etimesheets.ihss.ca.gov. The Electronic Timesheet option is currently available in three counties: Sacramento, Yolo and Riverside. Other counties will be able to use the services later this year.

Some benefits of this service:

- You will no longer be required to mail your timesheet
- You will receive online error messages and violation warnings to assist in submitting correct timesheet
- You can check payment status and payroll history online

Upcoming FREE Classes

IHSS Public Authority regularly holds classes on a variety of subjects related to caregiving! All classes are open to both Providers and Recipients, and are held on Thursday evenings as scheduled below. Classes begin at 5:30pm and end by 7:30pm. All classes are held at 3701 Branch Center Road, unless otherwise specified. Take a look at some upcoming classes:

August 10th: How to Prevent Caregiver Burnout through Self-Care. Presented by Bereavement and Volunteer Programs staff with the UC Davis Hospice program. In this class, we will discuss the importance of self-care, how to set boundaries and maintaining balance in one's life.

August 24th: Home Safety and Universal Precautions*: Presented by IHSS Public Authority staff, this class will discuss ways to stay safe on the job and how to maintain an injury-free environment for Providers and Recipients.

September 7th: Maintaining Boundaries and Professionalism. Presented by IHSS Public Authority staff, this class will discuss how to maintain a professional relationship between Providers and Recipients, including setting and maintaining healthy boundaries.

September 28th: Community Resources to the Rescue*. Presented by Jeff Parker from Shield Health Care, this class will discuss various medical products and services available through the Medi-Cal insurance program.

*Indicates Core Class. Core classes provide information on the basic issues and skills each Provider needs to do their job safely, and helps Providers become more proficient in their work. A certification of completion is given at the end of each class, and each core class completed is noted in the Provider's profile, enhancing interviews with prospective Recipients.

Tips to Avoid Violations

WIOLATION AND A STREET OF THE STREET OF THE

- Know your maximum weekly hours and remain within them
- Understand that a work week is from Sunday to Saturday, even if it crosses months or pay periods
- Understand that if you have multiple Recipients, you can never exceed 66 hours in a work week
- Use a pocket or wall calendar to track your time worked,
 as the work weeks are laid out the same
- Do not use a standard calculator to add hours and minutes
